

Om Shanti Everyone

We had never heard of drishti before, and even now, many ask, "What is drishti?" Baba says, "As is your drishti, so will be your shrishti, or world." Drishti is really sharing or meeting through the eyes, looking at the center of the forehead. I remember my first time to Madhuban. I prepared a lot, because all our Dadis and our instruments would say that if you're in soul consciousness, ShivBaba will come in Brahma Baba, but if you are not, He won't come. I remember on the train, we were practicing, "I am a soul, I am a point of light," because when we go in front of Baba and ShivBaba enters, we will have drishti. When we reached Madhuban, Baba and Mamma were both there in History Hall. When Baba gave me drishti, it was very powerful and it was a beautiful experience. I felt his drishti cleansed me and everything got filtered, I felt so much purity. I can never forget that experience. Even though I was young and pure and had never had any thoughts about vice, this experience of purity was so powerful.

When we are giving drishti, sharing drishti through our third eye in soul consciousness, we are looking at the other one as a soul. Then, because Baba is Ever Pure, and whatever degrees of purity I have, what I am sharing or should be sharing, is just Purity. Now, when we think of drishti, if you're looking at someone or sharing drishti and if there is a subtle attitude or thoughts like, "Oh, she looks like this, she is like that." So, what am I seeing? Not only that, but another experience with Baba and Mamma was their loveful drishti. That loveful drishti is like knowing them, not intellectually, but there is a sense of belonging, we know each other and we are for each other. Our drishti should carry that purity, and that pure love, soul conscious love, that instantly connects and gives a feeling of belonging. There are so many people who might not like knowledge. However, you will always find someone, even a stranger, who will look at you, and you look at that person. Sharing drishti not intentionally or in soul consciousness is a common way, right? That's how we meet. If I maintain this soul conscious stage of love, God's love and purity, then I everyone meet will have some feeling of connection and belonging.

So, we share drishti, but actually the whole day, even when you're traveling, anywhere you go, there is this connection that happens. Then when there are pure feelings, so that person feels some attraction. Once, I was in Brazil and there were speakers from different countries. One of them was from Lebanon, and as we were going up on the stage, he looked at me and I also looked to acknowledge him. Suddenly, there was that connection, and after that I became aware that it's not a question of when you are giving drishti, but anytime we meet someone. There are so many experiences that we should maintain this all the time, with everyone. How do I look at everyone? Baba said that we look at everyone as a soul. However, you are also radiating love and peace,

Baba's presence, soul consciousness, and purity. We are not only talking about drishti amongst Brahmins, but also generally wherever my eyes focus. I can also connect with nature and the elements immediately. In this, big transformation can happen, and also, Baba said that I have so much to receive from nature, such as happiness and love, and not sorrow.

It's not always about words and speaking, but there are different kinds of energies, like sadness, pain, and sorrow. There is starvation in the world and people not getting food. In spite of that, what should I receive? Always always take something positive, with very good feelings. Of course, what I give will be 100% pure feelings and God's love for everyone. We all can do that, right? Wherever we go, create loving beautiful pure feelings. Create such an environment where everyone receives something through our drishti, and that's what even Baba said today, to "be donors", right? Donation is not only speaking words of knowledge, but it is just our love, and soul consciousness towards other souls, and they would have never felt that before. A beautiful relationship of soul consciousness is shared through our pure and loving drishti.
