

Om Shanti!

Congratulations for being here every evening! Baba's loves each one. We listen to Baba everyday. How many of you have 100% faith, "I was deity", devta, can I see hands? I don't think there is anyone who didn't raise their hands, who has a little doubt about being a deity. We think of emerging divine sanskars, so you always have to think, "I was a deity." What exactly do deities give? What they are giving in silence, is exactly what Baba is telling us today. That is what we have to give, that's what we have to do, we have to have pure feelings and good wishes. Baba says that your feelings will touch the hearts. Your pure drishti will reach far away, and those who are in contact will come into close relationship. All that Baba is saying will happen through pure thoughts and good wishes. If you are giving knowledge intellectually alone, people will say it is very good, but if you are not serving through the mind, they will not be able to continue. That means, we are all together supporting each other, through creating vibrations of good wishes. We know there is one strength and one support. We create this atmosphere where there is love, peace, and always good wishes for each one. Never think, "Oh, this one didn't do, this is right, this is wrong." That is very gross thinking. Just have good wishes for everyone, so that whatever anyone is doing, they can do better and better through our wishes. We always want people to perform better, do better, and not make mistakes, but they are doing their best, so I am sharing my pure and good wishes. We are listening to Baba again and again about good wishes. I now know that is the qualification of a deity.

Baba said that you have to accumulate the power of peace, and the power of silence. First thing, don't ever get upset. Set yourself in the seat of peace, the seat of love. Upset means you have left your seat. That is not service, nor is it being in the divine family. One of the most important things that we can bestow and share with each other is pure feelings and good wishes. Yes, it is a very high aim, but Baba said that you all were deities, right? Emerge those divine sanskars. Baba says, "Hum So, So hum, what I was, I am again becoming that." As much as you think like this, the deity within you will awaken more and more. If possible, we should do this all day. Also, our drishti towards each other should be that of family, we need each other, we don't need anything from worldly people. Baba gives us everything. We are together, living together, doing service together, we maintain our pure feelings and good wishes for everyone, and we also have divine drishti towards everyone. When we do that, we are serving not only as angels, but as deities. Baba says that anyone who comes in front of you, don't just start giving knowledge, no, that is why there is a practice of sitting for a few minutes in remembrance of Baba. What you are doing in remembrance of Baba is that you emerge your own divine form, and from that, emerges your thoughts and drishti.

Baba says that peace and silence are two powers that are very important. Realization and transformation should happen in less than a minute. Even if I know I am right, thinking that this one is wrong is wasting time and also our stage is lost. Accumulation does not happen like that. These two powers, if we pay attention, they get accumulated then you feel internally it is filling you with your own divine power, and that image of a deity is

emerging. When we do everything through the intellect, then it is a lot of work. What Baba is saying is simple, just have pure wishes for everyone, everyone has love for Baba, faith in Baba, everyone wants to be together with Baba. Baba is waiting in the subtle region, and we all have to go together, right? I think if we spend 20 minutes in 24 hours you will see the impact of it in Amritvela, you will feel you are in a divine world. Baba says that we create with Him, we are world benefactors like Him. We are familiar with what we are creating, we are creating a divine world. Our part in the Confluence Age is only for a few years. I have to accumulate powers so that my every thought serves in a very natural way, that's what unlimited service is. Can you talk and do things for an unlimited time? Nobody can. However, I can be a consistent server by having pure feelings. That means every feeling for everyone, whether they come in front or they are far, wherever every soul receives something, then I am contributing towards the establishment of the divine world. My divine sanskars are pure feelings and good wishes, whether they appear through my drishti, my presence, or through thoughts, words and actions. When you do this, you are helping many souls, there are many who will be inspired to do this.

Why are murlis being revised? We heard the murlis of 1969, now it's 1989, listening to it now it feels different. If we could have done it, we would have been deities already. Baba is asking us to revise, because it is another opportunity. These days, you get so much news about physical sickness, so many obstacles, people calling for blessings and saakash. Sure, I am happy to do that, and I will. Baba says that our consistent stage is the biggest challenge we should accept. I definitely feel that when I see souls getting engaged in small things, it's like again something is emerging from vices, so I will say with a lot of love for all Baba's children, let's create the new world, the divine world of heaven. We must experience it, if we haven't experienced it, we won't be able to be happy, that means we won't go there, you won't get to enter there. So, whatever we are doing here, if we haven't accomplished what needs to be accomplished, then we have to be a little bit careful. Baba says to be careful with what you are doing, and remember what Baba wants us to do. Today, I am also seeing the Thai family, they are getting ready for Thursday morning. Murli is finished and they are ready to offer bhog. Om Shanti, nice to see you all spiritually, you look like holy swans.
