

Om Shanti everyone!

Baba is talking about divinity, being alokik. Our original stage is divine. The eternal stage of the soul is love, peace, and purity, then we begin the cycle with all virtues, and this is our 'original' life. There is a lot of inner contentment and happiness. In relationships, there is joy and happiness, but also, we stay very connected with nature. Nature gives us a lot of happiness, and it's a very beautiful feeling whether it's birds or nature, everything. Baba says that we should stay full with the treasure of divinity, and that means having a divine intellect and divine eye. Souls who have divinity have a lot of beautiful experiences. We have been practicing so that we can be the embodiment of what we are thinking. Every thought that I create, instantly gets practical, it gets accomplished. Today, our practice was royalty. Baba says that life at the Confluence Age is more interesting than life in the Golden Age. In the Golden Age, it will be a good life, but at the Confluence Age, it is a life of service, a life of dedication and inculcation. An important quality is humility. They give an example of the tree that if it's loaded with fruit, then it's always bowing. So, one who has powers, one who has authority, one who has all the qualities will always be humble and then of course when the tree is loaded with the fruit and it bows.

Baba gives us time to accumulate silence. According to Drama, we get to contemplate, we get to go deeper. Humility is not just a question of bowing, but of having respect for everyone. No one is big or small, rich or poor, no, just respect everyone. When you are respectful, you get blessings from Baba, but true humility comes through the incorporeal stage. Baba is incorporeal, and all His acts are benevolent, because when you are incorporeal, you are also egoless. We have to make humility our virtue, with no ego of any kind. They use shrimat, but also sometimes they mix their intellect in shrimat, in very subtle ways. With humility, comes respect for Baba's shrimat. What is respect for Baba? To listen, to study properly is respect for Baba, respect of the Teacher. Following shrimat is respect for Satguru Baba. If we say 'ha ji', that is also respect to Baba. You haven't seen Brahma Baba in the physical, but when Avyakt BapDada comes, He's so loving and respectful to everyone. He doesn't discriminate. In the same way, our vision, our attitude, and our drishti should be very respectful. Today was about Royalty. So, you had the feeling of being prince-princess of Baba, right? Baba really keeps us as prince-princess, He just says to have the awareness, don't forget what you're becoming. So, I think we will need time to reflect on how to make yourself full of divinity, then royalty, and from there, humility, this is very important.

Brahma Baba is a practical example of what He teaches us. We saw that humility and respect, that every child should make good efforts. He was helping everyone, even that young girl who would come a few times and ask Baba, "Are you in Baba's remembrance?" Baba said, "Yes." Then Baba said that she was having difficulty

remembering Baba, and because of that, Baba told her, "You come and ask me." Will we do that? We would just say why does she keep asking again and again? So, look at the humility that he's helping every soul, helping Dadi Chandramani, helping this young girl. That's the respect Baba has for each child. We had been doing these stories because they are very amazing stories. All these young girls when they came and how they became Dadis, and expanded the service in different states of India. Baba sent them to different states. Dadi Chandramani knew a little bit of English, not much. So, Baba sent her to Bangalore because in Bangalore people speak their local language, but they speak English, too. Of course, we heard the experience that she didn't know English, and Baba taught her in a way, she got this as a gift.

You all saw Madhuban on Saturday when Baba came. It was such a beautiful feeling. The whole day, we were feeling as if we're in Madhuban. It was so fulfilling. Baba kept saying to the children that there could be something suddenly, and to be ready. This was a beautiful Murli, preparing us for the Golden Age where there will be one kingdom, one religion, one law and order, that is Baba's shrimat. It was really such a presence of Baba. We cannot say that it's a revised Murli, then it's only a video, no, it was real. How many of you felt that? How many of you felt the presence of Baba that day? The whole day, here we were saying, "Where are we?" Oh, we are in Madhuban! About 6000 - 7000 from different states go as before, first sevadhari's go, they prepare, then Baba's children go in large numbers. In Rajasthan, they say it's like open now, there's no cases of Covid, and so that is why they come in a good crowd, and it seems that everything is going very well. So, we asked them when could double foreigners come? They were laughing because they said, "When your government will open it, they will allow you, then we will also prepare for it." So, we were asking them if they would give us one separate building, so all can stay together there, or to arrange something, because they already had planned for thousands to be there. We also need to send a lot of good wishes for Ratan Mohini Dadi. She was not there that day because her body was not too well. We also have to give a lot of good wishes to Nirwair Bhai, because he also had to go to Ahmedabad today. So, every day we have contact with Madhuban as if we are there, and they are also saying, "Yes we are invoking, we welcome double foreigners when they come, let us know." So, let's see how the visas, embassies, airlines, how things are, and based on that, we will see who will be courageous to go. Madhuban is our home, and of course we all miss Madhuban. I remember last time there were some souls saying, "Should we go?" I said, "As long as you can go, go, because you don't know what will happen. I didn't realize that we wouldn't be able to go for two years. It will open for us, and then we will take a chance and go. Okay! Let's remember Baba now.
