
The inspiration was brought to fruition by enthusiasm and teamwork from the students across all Southern California Centers and Study Places initiated by students from the Los Angeles Center.

A magnificent, 41'x28' shivalingam was designed and built by students of Pasadena Study Places. The posters were created, designed and built by students in Cerritos, Laguna Beach and Canada. Instruments from across Los Angeles came together to develop and execute the program.

Each day, the Exhibition Program was displayed and made available to the public hourly for 8 hour-slots.
