Pre-COP Global Faith Leaders' Summit

Uniting Faith Leaders for Planetary Resurgence, Nov. 6 - 7, 2023, Abu Dhabi, UAE

More than 200 Faith Leaders, Scientists, Youth, Business Leaders, Women Leaders, and Politicians, came together in Abu Dhabi 6-7 November to unite their voices and adopt a powerful Interfaith Statement. The Global Summit was co-hosted by UNEP Faith for Earth, the Muslim Council of Elders, COP 28 Presidency, and the Ministry of Tolerance and Coexistence of UAE. Inclusivity was the main message of the opening session. Twelve religious leaders shared their message including Vatican Secretary of State and representative of His Holiness Pope Francis, together with representatives from Islam, Buddhism, Sikhism, Hinduism and Brahma Kumaris.



Sister Maureen Goodman, Director of Brahma Kumaris in the United Kingdom, spoke of how the condition of the natural environment depends entirely on human behaviour. Behaviour has its root in our awareness. Our awareness has a profound impact on our planet. Our awareness defines our attitude; our attitude colours our vision; our vision drives our actions; our actions create our world. To restore nature to its original pure state we need to practice



the deep prayer, reflection and meditation that lies at the heart of each of our traditions, and to deepen our connection with the Divine. This connection enables us to draw strength and courage to live by the most elevated ethics and values, to live by the religion of truth, purity and non-violence.

Sister Maureen met the President of UAE, His Highness Sheikh Mohamed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan during a Majlis at the Presidential Palace (special gathering or council).
