

LOVING TRIBUTE TO DADI JANKI

- An Extraordinary Woman who left a Legacy of Love & Wisdom



Brahma Kumaris Malaysia (BKM) organised an on-line programme entitled “Loving Tribute to Dadi Janki” on Sunday 28 March 2021. It was in memory of Dadi Janki who became avyakt at the age of 104 on 27 March a year earlier.

The opening words of the first song: “A tiny flower breaks the storm...” together with the love and gratitude expressed by the MC, carried the essence of Dadi’s extraordinary life.
