# Didi Nirmala's visit to Sri Lanka, September 2014

#### **COLOMBO**

On the afternoon of 5 Sep, Didi Nirmala along with Sr Jyoti, arrived at Colombo International Airport and was welcomed and transported to the BK Centre by Br Ganesh and Dr Mohan. Arriving at Harmony House, the main centre in Sri Lanka, Didi briefly met everyone who had come to receive her. In the evening a short welcome program was conducted, followed by a class by Didi and sharing of experience by Sr Jyoti for about 80 BKs.

During the weekend the BK family in the Colombo zone had a retreat with Didi on the theme of "Being with One". On Saturday the sub-theme "Ocean of Forgiveness" was taken up with around 145 participants. The same evening BKs from all the centres in the Colombo zone took the chance of an empowered evening of meditation with Didiji. The next day, Sunday, there was another sub-theme "Karankaravanhar" for more than 200 BKs.

In the evening a public program was arranged especially for a group of 30 female contacts and Didi addressed the topic "Balancing Relationships and Responsibilities". Guests included the Additional Secretary of Ministry of Buddhasasana, a famous artist, members from the Inner Wheel Club of Colombo which is the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest women's organisation in Sri Lanka and many other professionals, who all took benefit of a spiritual evening with Didiji. On Monday 8<sup>th</sup> morning Didiji left for Jaffna to meet the BKs in the Northern province.

Ven Bhikkuni Kusuma, MA, PhD, is a fully ordained Buddhist nun from Sri Lanka who has pioneered the reestablishment of the Theravada Female Buddhist Order in Sri Lanka. She is the first woman in Sri Lanka to don the robes of a Bhikkuni after a lapse the Bhikkhuni order for nearly 1,000 years. Her doctoral dissertation on Bhikkuni Vinaya (rules of discipline for ordained Buddhist nuns) is regarded as a handbook for Buddhist nuns in Sri Lanka. Now in her eighties, she continues to be active in bringing the higher ordination of Buddhism to women in Sri Lanka as well as abroad.

Didi Nirmala returned to India 18 Sep. 19 September 2014
